On June 12, 2019, the Canadian Government published the technical specifications required to be compliant with its Electronic Logging Device mandate, scheduled to take effect in January 2023. The Canadian ELD mandate will apply to all Canadian commercial drivers and those U.S.-based commercial drivers crossing into and operating within Canada who are required to prepare hours-of-service (HOS) and records of duty status (RODS). While the Canadian ELD requirements closely follow the existing U.S. ELD requirements, one significant difference is the Canadian requirement that the ELD device be certified by a government-accredited independent third party. ORBCOMM is highly supportive of the third-party certification requirement, having voluntarily submitted its ELD to a rigorous third-party certification audit in the U.S.

ORBCOMM is committed to the Canadian transportation market. We are already leveraging our extensive experience and investment in the third-party certification process in the U.S., along with our involvement with the governing bodies, to position us to achieve the mandated third-party certification for the Canadian market well ahead of the January 2023 deadline.
